## **Rules and Regulations**

1. All stallions must be registered with papers.
2. All stallions must be shown by an adult.
3. Exhibitors of Draft Horses are encouraged to bring their animals in on Friday evening. However, they have until 8:30 a.m. on Saturday morning to do so.
4. Animals may not be shown in more than one class except where indicated.
5. Judges are responsible to disqualify animals not shown in proper classes or sections or not in condition to be shown.
6. Interfering with the judge's decisions will not be permitted.
7. Entries must be in the office on or before Wednesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>.
8. An exhibitor infringing any of the rules will forfeit any money to which he or she may otherwise be entitled.
9. The Fair authorizes a breeding unit to enter 2 exhibits per section in a maximum of 3 sections. Only ONE entry will be accepted in group sections.
10. Every exhibitor or attendant must be in the ring to take charge of his or her respective animals while being judged, as management is not responsible for animals not being shown.
13. Diligence will be used by the committee to prevent injury to, or loss of property, but they will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
14. The Association will not assume the responsibility to pay the prize money in full if receipts of the day are not sufficient to meet expenses.
15. All exhibitors will be charged admission fees. Exhibitors showing 4 animals will be reimbursed ONE admission to grounds; 5 - 8 animals – TWO admissions; 9 or more animals – THREE admissions.
16. All entries are to be made in accordance with the above rules and regulations, and each and every exhibitor agrees to be governed by the same in entering exhibits of any kind.
17. All exhibitors must show proof of insurance.
18. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> can show in champion classes.
19. All exhibitors must be on time when announced to show or gate will be closed.

## P.E.I. Horse Pullers Association Rules

*The PEI Horse Pullers' Association requires all owners and all teamsters to have insurance and a proof of insurance must be made available.*

1. Horse Pull is open to the Maritimes with a limit of 20 teams with registration being first come first serve starting Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. There is a registration fee of \$10. To register, call (902) 854-3517 or e-mail expositionfestival@gmail.com
2. Horses will be weighed with halter and loose shank.
3. Teamsters must show proof of liability insurance when being weighed.
4. All horses are subject to drug testing. No drugs are allowed. Feed and water buckets are disallowed once horse pull has started. If anyone is caught using them, they will be disqualified.
5. Light draft team to weigh 3000 lbs and under / Middle weight teams to weigh 3000-3400 lbs / Heavy teams to weigh 3400 lbs and over.
6. The pulling position for the teamster will be the lightest team to drag first. The heaviest team last in each division. Starting weight will be decided upon an agreement amongst the teamsters before the pull. Tentative added weight to be 700lbs.
7. Pulling distance will be 12 ft. in any 2 starts. Two attempts to move the drag the required distance. The winner of the pull will be the team that moves the drag the most inches on the heaviest load. Three minutes to complete the pull from the time your name is called.
8. Any movement of the drag will be called a try once the teamster has hooked his team to the drag. Also, on any one start when unhooking, if the drag is moved more than 4 inches from the time they stop and unhook from the drag, that would be considered a try and anything under 4 inches will be subtracted from the overall length. Teams must be unhooked from the drag between each try. No excessive hauling of the drag.
9. Lines will be 14 ft. apart. Any horses stepping on the line while hooked to the drag will be counted as a try but disallowed as a good pull.
10. If the team steps on the line before being unhooked from the drag on a good pull, it will be disallowed. Horses must stay in between lines until unhooked from the drag.
11. Use of reins only allowed in forward of hands. No butt reins or over the hands are allowed. Any teamster swinging on the team intentionally will be disqualified.



12. No roughing horses coming or leaving the drag or you will be disqualified. No cruelty to horses on pulling grounds.
13. Any teamster starting the pull with a team must stay with that same team for the entire pull, except for injury.
14. Teams will pull round robin style or single class depending on the number of teams.
15. If any team becomes unmanageable or difficult to handle and becomes dangerous to the public, the judge and officials have the right to and will disqualify the team and order the team from the pulling area.
16. After horses are hooked to the drag, one teamster only. No heading of horses unless in case of breakage or the horses are tangled up. In case of breakage, then the team will get fixed up while the pull continues but must come back and pull on the last of that load before more weight is added or ten minutes.
17. Any teamster judged to be under the influence of alcohol will not be allowed to compete.
18. Concerning all teams: If any horse of any team is so blemished, in poor condition, or lame, the judge shall have the right to eliminate that team.
19. After horses are hooked to the drag, hookers must step back and not talk or whistle at horses.
20. Teamsters will not exercise their team in the pulling area.
21. Each horse is only allowed in one class.
22. Horses must have on halters and be tied up in the pulling arena.
23. The judge's decision will be the final one.

3. Judges are responsible to disqualify animals not shown in proper class or section. The show committee will advise the exhibitor of the disqualification.
4. Interfering with the judge's decisions will not be permitted.
5. There will be a time limit of 5 minutes between classes.
6. An exhibitor infringing any of the rules will forfeit any money to which he or she may otherwise be entitled.
7. Ponies 14.2 hands and under 54" are to be ridden or shown by a junior who has reached his or her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year. We recommend ponies 12.1 hands and under to be ridden or shown by a junior who has not reached his or her 13th birthday as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year.
8. No cross entering is allowed in pleasure and halter classes and only ONE entry will be accepted in group sections. All entries in jumping classes use English tack with proper helmets and boots. Corrective footwear is required in Western classes.
9. Every exhibitor or attendant must be in the ring to take charge of his or her respective animals while being judged, as the management is not responsible for animals not being shown.
10. Diligence will be used by the committee to prevent injury to, or loss of property, but they will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
11. The Association will not assume the responsibility to pay the prize money in full if receipts of the day are not sufficient to meet expenses.
12. All exhibitors will be charged admission fees. Exhibitors showing 4 animals will be reimbursed ONE admission to grounds; 5-8 animals – TWO admissions; 9 or more animals – THREE admissions.
